A probable or laboratory confirmed COVID-19 positive staff/student is present in school during the infectious period of 48 hours prior to onset of symptoms or 48 hours prior to a positive test result



If BOTH the probable/confirmed positive case and student/staff contacts were:

- Wearing a mask **AND**
- > 6ft away

Regardless of the length of time


If EITHER the probably/confirmed positive case and student/staff contacts were one of the following scenarios:

- Wearing or Not wearing a mask **AND**
- <6 ft away, for 10+ minutes **OR**
- Not wearing a mask **AND**
- >6 ft away, for 60+ minutes (cumulative over day)

Busing, sports, band/chorus, and lunchroom exposure decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis



No quarantine required

Quarantine required for those sitting in front, side to side and behind the probable/confirmed case 

Quarantine decided following investigation of circumstances

If at any time during isolation of a positive case, another staff/student who had proximate contact during the case's infectious period becomes symptomatic, the entire classroom will be quarantined, regardless if masked.

Per the CDC: People who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 3 months and recovered do not have to quarantine or get tested again as long as they do not develop new symptoms. [COVID-19: When to Quarantine | CDC](#)
