Unvaccinated PK-12 Student, Teacher or Staff member identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 (August 23, 2021)

The Genesee County or Orleans County Department of Public Health will issue a Quarantine Order



Individual is symptom free for 10 days from their last contact with the COVID-19 case.

AND

Individual is released from quarantine by the Genesee County or Orleans County Public Health.

While in quarantine, individual has a temperature >100° OR has symptoms of COVID-19 that are new or unusual for the individual.

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches



Individual can return to school.



Individual does not get a COVID-19 test: Individual remains in quarantine for 14 days.

COVID-19 test result is negative*: Individual remains in quarantine for the remainder of the 10 days.

COVID-19 test result is positive*: Individual is placed in Isolation for 10 days from start of symptoms by GCPH/OCPH.



***HOME TESTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

Individual is released from Quarantine or Isolation by GCPH/OCPH. INDIVIDUAL CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL.
