



Kindergarten screening will take place for the
Medina Central School District
at **Oak Orchard Elementary School** on
Monday, May 17 through Friday, May 21
from 8:00am until 1:15pm.

Any student who resides in the district who will be five years old by December 1st is eligible to attend. All students must complete a screening process for appropriate placement. The screening will take approximately 30 minutes to complete and will consist of an academic screen (letters, numbers, shapes, etc.) and a parent/guardian interview and information session. Valuable resources will be shared with students and families to help them continue to prepare over the summer.

A parent/guardian must attend with their child. Due to limited space and COVID regulations, we ask that only one adult and one child attend. Masks must be worn during the screening process by children and adults. Temperature screening will take place upon arrival.

You will also need to REGISTER your child for Kindergarten at the district office. You may start this process online on the district website or call for a paper packet. You will need to bring the following documents to the District Office: Original birth certificate, proof of residency (utility bill, mortgage statement, lease agreement), most recent health physical and list of child's immunizations. Students currently enrolled in the Pre-K program at Oak Orchard will complete the screening during school hours. Parents will be contacted via phone for the parent/guardian interview. Since they are already enrolled in the district, you will NOT need to register your child.
