MUSTANG BAND FALL FUNDRAISERS

All fundraisers are mandatory!

All fundraising money must be paid with a check or money order (no cash will be accepted) made payable to "Medina Mustang Band Boosters".

The boosters will set due dates for all fundraisers. All money dealing with those fundraisers are expected on or before the due date. Please make every attempt to adhere to these dates. We greatly appreciate your cooperation.

*Upon graduating or no longer participating in the marching band program, any excess money in a student's personal account will be forfeited unless there is a sibling to transfer the money to.

July 22nd - July 27th - Fair Parking

The band boosters and marching band students entering grades 9-12 are in charge of parking at the 4-H Fair (last FULL week in July). This is the BIGGEST fundraiser of the year! Students **MUST** sign-up in the high school band room during the last two weeks of school. Each student must sign-up for 3-4 time slots.

Parent Volunteers NEEDED for: Set-up, directing traffic, runners, & tear-down.

FALL CANDY SALE

We again will be running out annual candy sale. Each family will be responsible for selling 1 box of Niagara Chocolates. All members will get their chocolate on the first day of school. The money for the sold chocolate is due on or before October 18th! Please pay your \$50 by check made payable to the Mustang Band Boosters in a timely fashion. For those that wish to sell additional boxes of candy you can pre-order and pre-pay for additional boxes. These additional boxes will net \$25 into your child's account to use for their trip in the spring or other band items (shoes, rifles etc.).

September 7th - Pizza Sale #1 - 9:30 until Sold Out

Each pizza sale fundraiser requires every student in the marching band program and their parents to get involved and help. Pizza supplies are delivered on the Friday before each sale. September 20th - Fall Money Raffle

This fall we are going to run a money raffle that will be drawn on Friday September 20th. Each family will be expected to sell 8 raffle tickets. All tickets are \$10 so you will be responsible to turn in (by check - payable to the Mustang Band Boosters) \$80 by September 9th. The prizes for the raffle are 1st prize winner of \$2,000, 1 - 2nd prize winners of \$1000, 3rd prize winner of \$500 each and 7 - 4th prize winners of \$100 each. A total of 10 winners! If after you sell your initial 8 tickets for the organization and you would like to sell more tickets please see or contact Mr. Steele. If your family sells the 1st prize ticket (number) your child will go on the spring trip for FREE! So....sell as many as you can.

September 21st - Fall Festival of Bands

This fundraiser is the Medina Fall Home Show (competition) where the band boosters host anywhere from 8-15 bands. In addition it brings in close to 1,200 spectators to the Medina community! This is our opportunity to make Medina shine! We need all the parent volunteers we can get.

November 2nd – Pizza Sale #2 9:30am until Sold Out

STUDENT STAFF

Being chosen to be a member of the student staff is an honor and with that honor comes responsibility.

Student staff is expected to be at every rehearsal at least 15 minutes early to hand out drill cards, set-up yard markers/podiums, make sure everyone in their section is wearing sneakers, has useable reeds, clean horns, etc. If you cannot be at rehearsal early, you should pick an upperclassman in your section to take over your job for that rehearsal.

Student staff should be the first students to pass their music; at least one month after music has been handed out (as it is stated in your student staff application). Section leaders should then be helping and preparing the students in their section to pass their music ASAP. All students must pass their music with Mrs. Botsford or Mr. Steele.

For competitions or performances, student staff should report to the HS at least a half hour before the scheduled report time to help load equipment and be prepared to stay a few minutes late to unload at the end of the night.

*Many hands will make all of these jobs more time efficient!

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT AS A STUDENT STAFF MEMBER OF THIS BAND YOU ACT AS A ROLE MODEL TO THE YOUNGER STUDENTS, BE A GOOD LEADER!

UNIFORM GUIDELINES

- Make sure your uniform is **clean** for **ALL performances**.
- UNIFORM PANTS - Can be washed. **MUST** be hung to dry. **DO NOT PUT INTO DRYER!**
- SASHES - Do not wash!
- JACKETS - Take a wet wash cloth to it if needed. They can be **DRY CLEANED ONLY!**
**Each uniform is dry-cleaned twice a year, paid for by the band boosters.*
- INSIDE MATERIALS - The neck guard should be unsnapped and washed in your washing machine. Hang it up to dry.
- GLOVES - The booster uniform chairperson will take and wash after every performance.
- SHOES - Your drill masters should be clean for every show.
- UNDERGARMENTS - Students performing **MUST** wear white boxers or briefs. Colored underwear will show thru the white uniform pants!!
- All band members need to wear a **WHITE T-SHIRT** under their uniform.
- Please wear white tube socks or knee high white socks. No ankle or colored socks please!!
JUDGES watch and look for this!

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

All fundraising money is due on a designated date. We greatly appreciate your efforts to follow these dates. Due dates are set to give ample time to sell the products that are given to each family, and to put a completion date on each fundraiser. All of our products that we sell are purchased by the booster organization and therefore your payments help replenish this expense. Again your cooperation in paying on time is greatly appreciated.

Additional responsibilities:

All Color Guard and Band Members – Guard or Marching Shoes = \$40 – If you are brand new you will be fitted for your shoes at uniform fittings in August. If you are a current member and your shoes are yellowing, are overly scuffed up with black marks or the toe or heel are not fully attached it is time for a new pair. Please inform the uniform chair at uniform fittings in the summer.

Fall Band Registration Fee (*Fall season only*) = \$25 This fee covers events at band camp and also your child's show t-shirt for the fall season. **THIS YEAR THIS WILL BE DUE UPON SIGNING UP FOR THE FALL SEASON. WHEN YOUR CHILD TURNS IN THEIR PERMISSION SLIP PLEASE INCLUDE A CHECK FOR \$25 MADE PAYABLE TO THE MUSTANG BAND BOOSTERS.**

ALL Band Members – We hope that all of you continue into the spring season. Each Spring Season the band takes a trip. A large portion of the trip is paid for by the money earned from our fundraisers. The remainder of the trip is paid for by each band and color guard member. Each year the cost is different, but you can plan to spend approximately \$200 for this expense. Above this cost you will be responsible for some meals while we are away and any spending money you would want to bring.

For the spring season we have additional fundraisers as well that help assist in the funding of running the marching band and also to offset the remainder of the spring trip costs. These fundraisers will be listed in the spring marching band hand book.
