POSITIVE SCREENING/K-12 STUDENTS Student has a temperature >100.0° OR

Exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19:

Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell • Headache • Cough • Nasal congestion • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches

OR

Answered "Yes" to any other necessary screening questions (at home or at school) for the time frame of the past 14 days:

- Tested postitive for COVID-19;
- Been in personal contact with someone COVID-19 positive;
- Traveled to any restricted area per NYS Travel Advisory?

Student will remain at home, or be separated from others and sent home, and referred to family's health care provider.

No COVID-19 Suspicion

To return to in-person instruction, student must be symptom free and obtain:

- An evaluation document from health care provider.
- A lab-confirmed negative COVID-19 test result.



Confirmed Positive COVID-19 Test Result

GO Health will place student in Isolation, which lasts a minimum of 10 days.

Student can return to school after being released from Isolation by GO Health.
